How it started?

abhaya FOUNDATION has been established in the year 2006 with a mission to serve with 'H.E.A.R.T' (Healthcare, Educare, Awareness, Rural infrastructure and Transformation).



Mission is to serve with "H.E.A.R.T"

Healthcare:

abhaya offering free medical services, organizes health camps, hygiene drives and works on preventative medication thus addressing the root cause. Many a times there were instances in which abhaya has spent lakhs of rupees to save people who were suffering from chronicle diseases.



Educare:

abhaya supporting many meritorious students who are from economically weak background. As of day **abhaya's** Educare team consists of about 50 students (studying from KG to PG).



Awareness:

abhaya organizes Career Awareness Programmes for linking the youth with better opportunities and for enhancing their skills. As of now abhaya had interacted with about 2,00,000 of students and youngsters in the country. This Mission would continue further.



Rural Development:

abhaya always thinks in terms of developing rural communities. abhaya believes in teaching people how to earn roti instead of giving roti to them. Futher foundation wish to create "Value-Centers" in the villages that offer bouquet of services – ranging from center for medical service delivery to placing information kiosks. These centers will provide space for skill/attitude training, counseling and will act as mini classrooms.







Permanent Projects which need support



abhaya Vignan School, R. Nagabhushanam Yerragunta:

Established in a remote village of Anantapur District with a motto to provide support to poor teachers (10) and education on nominal cost to the primary level kids (200) with a nominal fee ranging from Rs.50/to Rs.150/-. Initial investment of Rs.5,00,000/- spent to add value to the infrastructure. If abhaya gets assured donations of Rs.25,000/per month the plan is to offer free education to the students.



Community Center:

Established at Yerragunta village based on the school infrastructure availability. AXIS Bank provided 5 computers; abhaya provided 2 sewing machines with an aim to train the unemployed vouth. Plan is to encourage unemployed youth in the villages.



Hunt the Winter:

This project has been initiated by abhava since its inception and as on date about 5000 blankets have been distributed across south Indian states during winter season. This project is permanent one. New blankets may cost around Rs. 100 each and every one can participate in this project(sevak@abahayafoun dation.org).



Saraswathy Vidya Mandir,

Tadipathri: A computer lab was established to impart computer education to the students from 1st class itself on a nominal cost of about Re 1/- per day. 6 computers and a printer was given to the school.

Orphan Care: In this project around 7 orphan kids are being cared for About Rs. 2,000/- per kid would be spent per month. Many more such orphans can be cared provided abhaya get regular and committed contributions on monthly basis.





Value Centers: These centers being planned to be set up for youth in all major cities where industries are present. The plan is to provide shelter, food, training, mentorship to those youngsters who are coming to the cities without any direction in life.

abhaya Home of Hoper This project is conceptualized with an outlay of Rs.1 crore to provide love and care to destitute in AP.
