

**From Baba's Classroom to a Digital Future:
abhaya Empowers 220 Girls at Bukkapatnam**



The Govt Girls High School, Bukkapatnam is one of the oldest institutions in the region, known for its commitment to quality education. This is the very school where Bhagavan Sri Sathya Sai Baba studied in his childhood. The classroom that once held him has since been preserved as a sacred memorial.

But for years, the campus faced a distressing challenge. Monkeys invaded the dining areas daily, leaving girls and boys anxious and unable to eat in peace.

abhaya stepped in with compassion.

As part of Baba's 100th Birth Anniversary celebrations, abhaya installed safety grills in the dining hall. The result: peace returned to every meal. Monkeys could no longer disturb the children.

During our visits, another gap became clear. Over 220 girls had no access to computer education — a critical skill for today's world.

Then came hope from Bengaluru.

Sri Subhash Sangham, a Google employee, came forward with deep resolve. He donated 10 computer systems and Rs. 2,00,000/- . Matching his generosity, Google sanctioned a grant of Rs. 2,00,000/- under its employee matching program.

The transformation is now real.

A full-fledged Computer Lab, built at an estimated cost of Rs. 5,00,000/-, was inaugurated on 20th April 2026. Smt. Pushpa Sangham, mother of Sri Subhash, inaugurated the lab in the presence of Swamy Balachandra, Sri J. Prathap Reddy, dedicated teachers, and our bright students.

This is more than infrastructure. This is dignity. This is opportunity.

From a room where Baba once learned, to a lab where 220 daughters will now learn to code, dream, and lead — the circle of service continues.

But the work is not done.

Hundreds of rural schools still lack basic digital access. Our daughters deserve the same tools as any child in a metro city.

ZPHS Dharmavaram Get a Safe Dining Hall**



Inspired by this, local well-wishers and community leaders contributed another Rs. 2,00,000/-

The impact is unfolding now.

With a total project cost of Rs. 5,00,000/-, construction of the dining shed is underway. Very soon, 650 girls will sit together, eat with dignity, and share laughter - without monkeys on the roof or strays at their feet.

This is more than a shed. This is safety. This is respect.

A place to eat is a place to belong. When we protect a girl's meal, we protect her right to learn without anxiety.

But Dharmavaram is not alone.

Across rural Andhra Pradesh, hundreds of government schools still lack basic dining infrastructure. Our daughters deserve better.

ZPHS Girls, Dharmavaram serves over 650 young daughters with dedication, shaping futures against all odds. But for years, mealtime meant fear.

The crisis: Monkeys, birds and stray dogs regularly invaded the open dining area. Girls could not eat in peace. Food was snatched, children were scared, and dignity was compromised every single day.

abhaya heard their silence.

Understanding that no child should choose between hunger and fear, abhaya initiated a permanent solution — a covered, secure Dining Hall.

Partnerships made it possible.

Regal Rexnord stepped forward with CSR sanction of Rs. 3,00,000/-.
