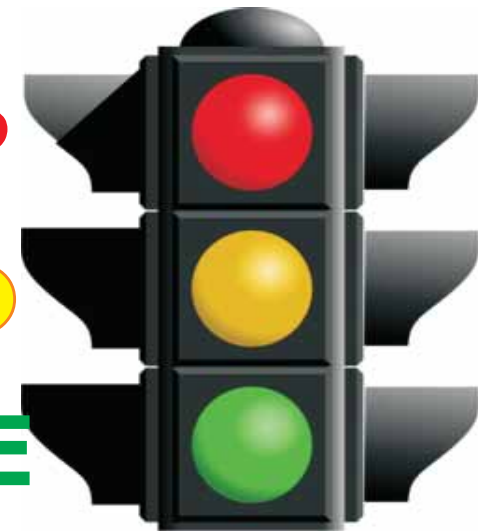

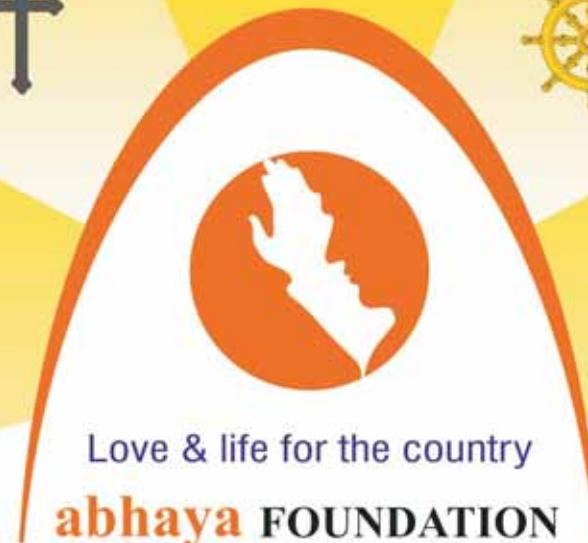

BSE-listed companies spend \$1 billion on CSR



Nearly 1,200 companies listed on the BSE together spent Rs.6,400 cr towards CSR activities in 2014-15, with majority of funds utilized for education, skills, health and sanitation sector, according to a report. The norms, which are applicable on a 1,294 BSE-listed companies, came into effect starting April 2014. Its almost 55 per cent. It added that only about two per cent of the funds have gone to Prime Minister's relief fund.

The findings, which are based on an analysis of disclosures made by 1,181 BSE-listed companies, done by CII-ITC Centre of Excellence for Sustainable Development, show that Maharashtra and Gujarat saw the most number of companies investing in CSR in states.

It added that more than 90 per cent of the 1,181 companies complied with CSR norm. 87 per cent of the eligible listed companies have actually spent on CSR though 52 per cent shelled out less than the two per cent requirement. About "83 per cent of those 52 per cent of the companies have given reasons for their under-spend," according to the report. Most firms initially lost time in understanding "a fairly complex piece of legislation". The other reasons for spending less were due to projects being multi-year or not finding the right projects or implementing agencies.

CSR platform goes live on BSE; projects worth Rs 2,000 crore listed

Sammaan, a platform to help companies find agencies for carrying out social welfare activities, has become operational on stock exchange BSE with more than 600 projects requiring funds of about Rs 2,000 crore listed on it as of now. The CSR platform, launched by BSE along with industry body CII and think tank IICA, went live on the stock exchange on December 9. Sammaan would help corporates undertake effective CSR activities by connecting them to non-profit and non-government agencies that have legitimate records. NGOs looking to fund their programmes would be required to list on Sammaan along with their projects, while companies are required to register themselves to access the segment.

According to BSE, there are about 20 lakh NGOs registered in India but there is considerable confusion among corporates on their legitimacy and credibility. Just as companies go through a process of registration and merchant banker scrutiny to list on the stock exchange, similarly, NGOs would also have to follow the listing procedures to list on Sammaan, Chakravarty said. "They (NGOs) are listed on Sammaan either through the certification process of the Indian Institute of Corporate Affairs (IICA) that works with six different ministries to get clearance for each NGO or through a recognized associate NGO partner of Sammaan such as Dasra, Credibility Alliance, HelpYour NGO," Chakravarty added. Every NGO would go through a check of its documentation, verification of projects by an associate partner or IICA and only then gets listed on Sammaan.

CSR can add to a company's bottom line

A new study has identified three common factors that ensure corporate social responsibility (CSR) adds to a company's bottom line. CSR has become a strategic part of most businesses and is used by

companies to advance some social good and also allows them to enhance their organisational performance. Most organisations are integrating social and environmental issues into their core strategies. But can organisations do well while doing good?

To answer this, academics reviewed 163 research papers from top-tier journals published from 2000 to 2014 on the link between CSR and company performance. In 'A review of the nonmarket strategy literature: Toward a multi-theoretical integration' published in the Journal of Management, Kemal Mellahi (of Warwick Business School), Jdrzej Frynas (of Middlesex University), Pei Sun (of Fudan University) and Donald Siegel (of University at Albany SUNY), argue the proper use of CSR can improve a company's performance and so ensure that by doing good they also do well.



Parliament panel dissatisfied at CSR fund spending:



A parliamentary panel led by senior BJP MP Shanta Kumar, which expressed dissatisfaction at the current attitude of companies towards spending their mandatory 2% corporate social responsibility (CSR), believes that if all the 21,429 profit-making private companies in the country diligently contribute, the CSR kitty will add up to a whopping Rs 7-8 lakh crore annually. The 131 profit making public sector units (PSUs) alone last year have contributed Rs 3,683.73 crore.

The panel, which also includes another senior BJP MP L K Advani, said in absence of an oversight and also lack of clarity within the Companies Act, the enterprises were frittering and at times, using this fund for marathons, sports activities and other publicity related gimmicks, rather in social programmes.

When the government's annual Plan spending is budgeted at Rs 4,65,277 crore, the addition of such large CSR amount will reduce poverty and raise lifestyles in geometric proportions, without even burdening the exchequer. "While many initiatives have been taken, the pattern of expenditure so far shows that it is not always targeted to the poorest or backward areas. We have, therefore, recommended that CSR should be clearly defined in the Act itself, to ensure allocations are spent for the specified activities," said Shanta Kumar.

Mandating CSR spends are "like a tax":Ratan Tata



Mandatory corporate social responsibility (CSR) spends for companies are "like a tax" and government needs to help identify beneficiaries, Tata Group chairman emeritus Ratan Tata said, adding that philanthropy is an act which comes from within.

"Philanthropy or giving is something that comes within you and you obviously create another motivation when you mandate that you will give 'x' or 'y'," Tata said, in comments that come days after Facebook's founder Mark Zuckerberg announced a plan to donate 99% of his \$45 billion fortune. "The mandated 2% the government has (enforced) becomes like a tax," Ratan Tata said,

referring to the government's decision on making CSR spends mandatory for companies above certain threshold at 2% of profits.

Tata, however, stressed that a huge amount of money gets generated through such contributions and it can be utilised better if the government can clearly identify projects or sectors which are need of funds. Tata, who retired as the chairman on Tata Sons in 2012 after being at the helm for over three decades, said that Tata Group companies have been devoting up to 5% of their profits for CSR for many years now.

Refusing to be drawn into a debate of 'good philanthropy' versus 'bad philanthropy' which has started following the announcements made by Zuckerberg and others, Tata said 'giving' is a new phenomenon which needs to be provided with the necessary time and space to grow and have course corrections. He also termed philanthropy as an act of doing something good for the society "without seeking to glorify yourself".

Mandatory Corporate Social Responsibility a blessing: Sudha Murty



Mandatory CSR spending is at the heart of corporate debate these days. A few days after Tata Group chairman emeritus Ratan had said that the 2% compulsory spending on corporate social responsibility (CSR) was similar to taxation, Sudha Murty, chairperson of Infosys Foundation, told HT that it was a blessing and not a 'tax' or financial burden.

Infosys Foundation is the multi-million dollar charitable arm of IT major Infosys. Murty, who writes her surname without the "h" unlike her husband and Infosys founder Narayana Murthy, said that the 2% rule has increased the foundation's ability to reach out to the needy by almost 10 times, from Rs 20-30 crore to Rs 260-280 crore.

"For me personally I feel the 2% CSR is very advantageous. I wish I could have got this when I was young. Now I get Rs 260-280 crore. It is 10 times more than what I used to get. It is so much money that I can work all over India. Otherwise I used to feel restricted because we had some Rs 20-30 crore. Now we can do unlimited work," she said.

Stating that the larger corpus allows the foundation to look at places where Infosys has no business interest, Murty said: "The people who receive help from us will not even know what Infosys is. For the last 19 years, thanks to the founders, they gave us money and told us to do whatever felt the best. They have not asked even once why we are doing what we are doing."

And once she had to turn down a higher education project favoured by Narayana Murthy since the foundation was focused only on primary education and funds were limited!



Ashiana Housing Receives Grant Of Canadian \$70000 For Its CSR Initiatives

Ashiana Housing has received grant of Canadian \$70000 (approximately Rs 35 Lakhs) for its CSR initiatives to educate and empower women folk by the Sustainability Innovation Grant fund (SIG fund). The award is instituted by Mennonite Economic Development Associates (MEDA), a Canadian organisation.

"If you economically empower a woman, she represents enormous opportunity that can actually be transformative not only for her family and for her community, but at the aggregate level for the economy." Keeping these few words in mind, Ashiana housing felt the need to take an initiative for women specific CSR activities like women's skill enhancement program. Under this project, they will be training 250 women within a period of 18 months and the total spends for the same is decided at Rs 70 lakhs including the grant received.

The company aims to utilise the whole amount for women's skill training programs, so as to make this section of the society independent and enable them to earn a better living. Through this initiative, women will be trained to become better masons, housekeeping and security staff, thereby increasing their employability quotient.

Chennai Flood: Walmart, its CSR Arm Commit Rs 1 Crore for Relief



Walmart Foundation have committed Rs 1 crore towards relief efforts for flood victims in Chennai and other parts of Tamil Nadu. "The Walmart Foundation has committed Rs 1 crore to Charities Aid Foundation India (CAF India) for the provision of health and hygiene kits, food baskets, safe drinking water and tarpaulins," Walmart said in a statement.

In addition, many Walmart India associates made immediate in-kind contribution (clothes and other urgent supplies) to NGO Goonj in response to the crisis, it added.

Walmart India president and CEO Krish Iyer said: "We stand by the people of Chennai and neighboring areas of Tamil Nadu who have been affected by the floods.

"In addition to the relief grant of Rs 1 crore by Walmart Foundation, we have pledged our support to the community through voluntary in-kind donations and volunteering activities."

Nasscom Foundation, Aricent launch CSR initiative:



Aricent and [Nasscom Foundation](#) today announced the launch of a CSR initiative under which 2,500 engineering undergraduates across Karnataka, [Tamil Nadu](#), Rajasthan and Delhi-NCR will be given training to upgrade their employability.

Nasscom Foundation along with Aricent has identified two training partners, iPRIMED and Global Talent Track, to carry out the on-campus skills development under the 'Aricent Employability Programme'.

The training will be delivered through a series of online and classroom sessions, including project work and learning events like project competitions, tech talks and industry leadership talks, among others, he said.

Programme culmination will include a joint certification from Nasscom SSC, Aricent, [Training Partners](#) and Nasscom Foundation, Sinha said. The students will also be given placement assistance at the end of the course through regular job fairs and campus connect [programmes](#) conducted by Nasscom Foundation and the training partners, he said.

Adani announces CSR projects worth 35cr



Adani group chairman Gautham Adani has announced corporate social responsibility (CSR) programmes worth Rs 35 crore for

the welfare of people residing around the upcoming Vizhinjam seaport project.

"The roll out of the CSR initiative - Theera Samrudhi - would be over three years. The funds would mainly be spent in the fields of health, sanitation, drinking water projects and upgradation of local schools. We can ensure the fishing community that the port will never be a hindrance in their life. Instead, it would support and foster the future in several ways," he said. Adani said the group would also help members of the local public to upgrade their skill sets to explore business and job opportunities that come up along with the project. "We have provided all support to the local community everywhere we operate ports," he said.

Sharekhan office at Chennai stocked the material for couple of days and hosted coordination meeting at their office in spite of holidays.

4th December – 8th December 2015

abhaya provided 200 blankets to a Volunteer heading to TN on 4th Dec 2015:



My name is S.D.Rajan. I don't belong to any organisation. We were just a group of schoolmates who were chatting on the whatsapp group and someone asked me whether I being a diver and an expert in water, can they take my help in serving the Chennai affected. This was at 5 pm yesterday. I said let's send some water and biscuits. I asked another group if they know where I can pick up biscuits, and before I knew it I had 1000 packets of biscuits. I went from 1 car to 2 cars of material, then to 1 tempo, then 1 canter..... and now I

am looking at 2 or even 3 canters. I have already received 2000 ltrs water, 1000 ltrs milk, 250 blankets, Honestly I don't even know what more is coming. The above items are all almost ready. Now you have offered us blankets...and bread. We have decided to target Kanchipuram with one truck and have 10 volunteers go there personally and hand over the relief stuff. Every truck will have its own set of volunteers.

Assuming I have enough material I will send a second truck to Cudalore as I understand that it is much more affected than Chennai. My contacts in Chennai have told me that they have enough food there just that its not reaching the people, but Kanchipuram and Cudalore and in bad shape. Sir, honestly this is the first time that I am handling this kind of procurement. I am normally a rescue expert. I thank you again for all the help extended and I will make sure that all the material Is delivered properly and photos taken to ensure proper documentation – **SD Rajan, Bengaluru, Karnataka**

We want large number of bed sheets & please help our people, if possible please send 1000 blankets so that we will distribute properly and send you photographs. Particularly this is for Irula community people in and around Thiruvallur and Kanchipuram District and other remote villages. – **J Prabhakar, Founder, NDSO, Chennai, TN**

Will send area wise statistics of material distributed soon. Yesterday we have distributed 50 blankets and matt and 20 saries for Anakaputhur. Today we have distributed 150 blankets remote village near ECR road personally distributed by me and Usha Balasubaramanian and her husband – **CS A Rengarajan, Company Secretary, Chennai**



abhaya blankets (50 reached to Tambram, 50 to Vyserpadi, 100 at west Mambalam , 50 to in Velachery. When the distribution starts it gets so difficult and hectic, there was no time for photos. At Vyserpadi,, , we were just 2 and the time was 10PM. When we took the blankets out, people started fighting with each other and climbing over each other to take blankets, so I had to stop issue of blankets. There was a couple of people who almost got trampled over. So we had to leave the place in a hurry. Otherwise that was the area that really needed it. That is why on Sunday I took police force. The police constable Shobana, who joined us in distributing the material was dynamic, and really controlled the crowd. And special thanks to ACP Saidapet Thangarajan. If not for him, we would never have done so much on Sunday. Police were with us from 8 to almost 9 in the night. No proper time for food or water. I think I gave them break 3 slices of bread at 4.30 in the evening and water. That was how busy we were. One road had not received food of any kind. Ours was the first to get there.



What I did notice is there was no government agency doing any kind of relief work. Where ever we went it was the local youth who helped us. And joined us to help going place to place with us. By end of day we had 12mor 13 youngsters with us. There is a need of blankets all over. I am trying to send 1200 blankets to TN tomorrow from Blore. abhaya can also arrange them from its pool. – **S D Rajan (who lead the relief team to TN from Blore with whom we have sent 200 blankets)**

Who are they???: Irula is a community. They live on snake catching. As they are not afford to pay rent anywhere in civil societies... they normally settle on the banks of lakes / rivers (Perungalathur lake). This area where we went is about 5kms from Tambaram and 40kms from Chennai central it will roughly around 35 to 40kms



seeing rice in the bags...such was their waiting!!!

It was literally heart breaking situation for us seeing many of them has 3 or 4 kids. All of them raised up their hands above their heads to thank us the volunteers who visited them late in the evening (we travelled after finishing our jobs). We finished distributing 40 grocery kits and 50 kotchnr utensils kits at 9PM in the night. We have also distributed toiletries for their use



How they were spotted and served???: I have been to Mudichur and Manimangalam to see my Superior Officer Sekhar, who is staying in indranagar 1st street. We went to rescue him, there were still 12 more streets are deeper inside which I couldn't able to reach them during floods. Now we went there to see how they are!

We are not sure about they having ration / voter card and obviously politicians seen them as no humans. All the volunteers went to College to call Mr . Rangarajan and his friends. Both of them were busy. But this did not stop me going there...in fact my Husband was there and stood as a one women army. I guess for 5 days they don't have any one enquired since govt closed relief camps nearby 5 days ago. I have to really thank abhaya and obviously Balachandra Sir, for giving us such an opportunity to serve the under privileged. Dhideer Nagar is about 3 kms from Mooladai, Chennai. I had been there on last Saturday. Each day since rains stopped, the water level has come down, but still many huts damaged have not let the people to come back to normal life. 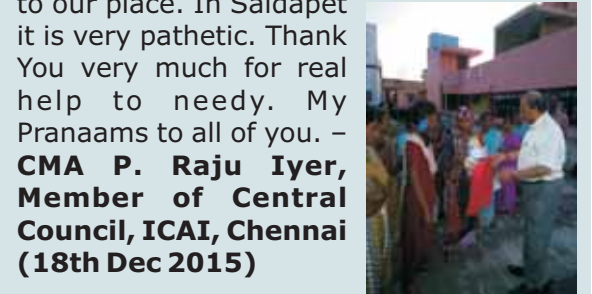

We served about 200 families in 5 different places. I have received abhaya Sharekhan HIL sponsored material and we identified needy people. The material was distributed by the volunteers (Gowtham & 2 students). They identified most affected areas in south Chennai Perumbakkam, Padhuvancheri, Kovilambakkam and Sunnambukulam , he asked for 300 utensil kits, mats and bed sheets, but personally I visited that area though they are all affected by flood, their houses are not damaged, so we distributed 25 mats and bed sheets only. Then distributed 108 utensil kits to Saidapet river bridge slum people and transgender people with the help of Swetha , transgender leader who runs a trust for transgender, Aravind, Loyola College - MSW student and many volunteers. We further distributed 10 mats and bed sheets to visually challenged home. Kannan from dindugal received them on their behalf along with medical kits. The area which we covered were adyar river bed, Saidapet and Jafferkhan pet. The total material received (60 bed sheets, 110 mats 35 medical kits & 108 utensils) were distributed along with rice, cereals and food stuff to those people which we got from some other donors – **Shivakumar (Advocate) NDSO, Saidapet, Chennai (24th Dec 2015)**

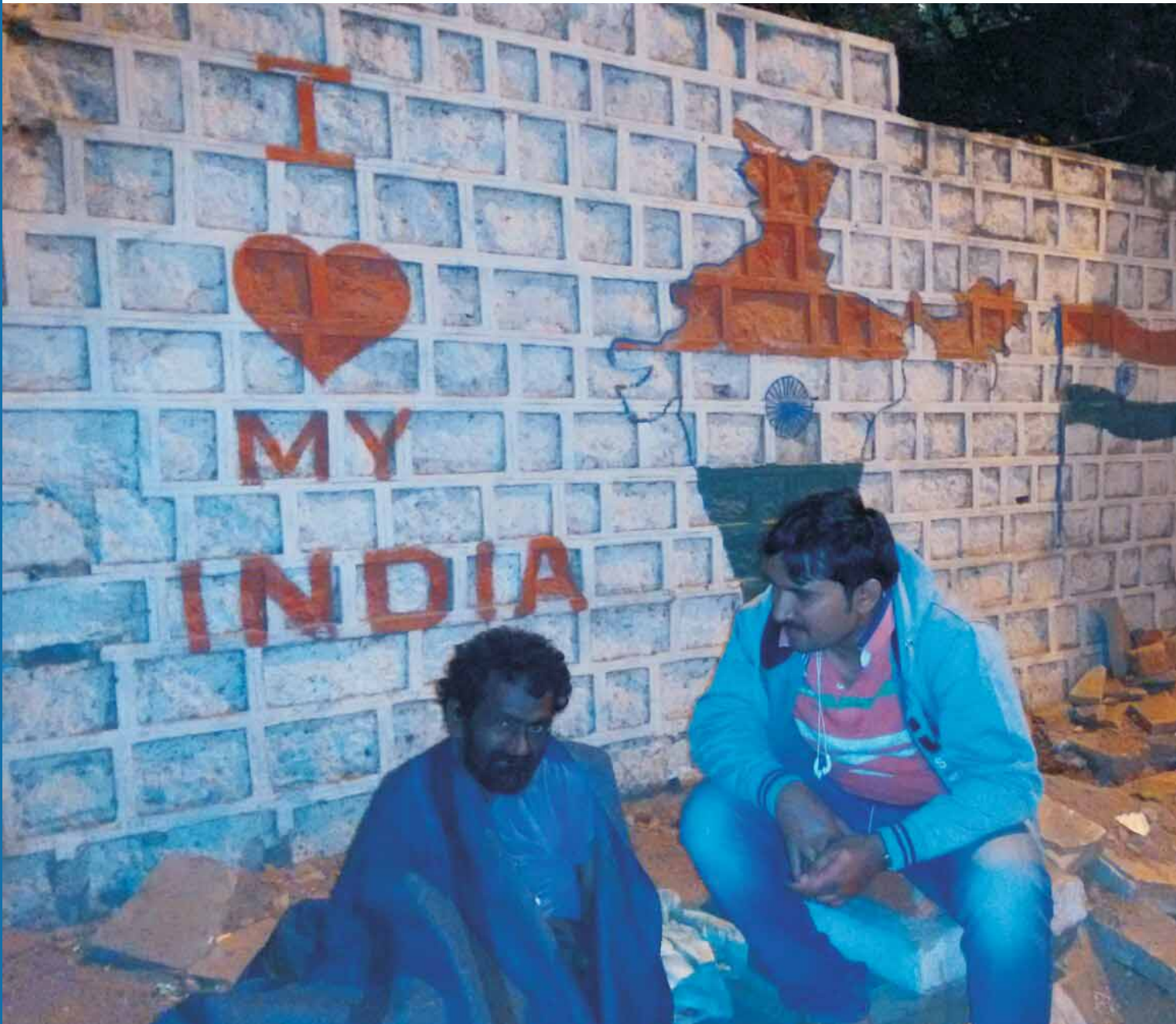

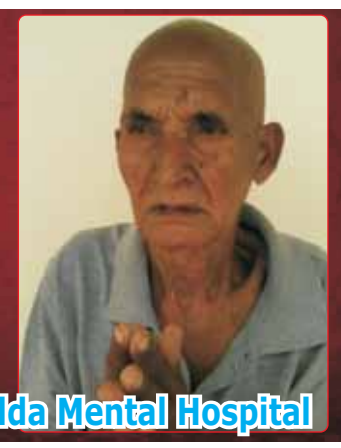

Mission Bhargavi

Bhargavi (my wife) suffering with blood cancer since 4 years and unfortunately the life saving tablets are not working, now the condition became serious. In march, 2015 in narayana hrudayalaya the doctors treated with chemo therapy and hospitalized for 34 days. Then the total hospital bill was Rs. 750000/-. Some of our friends gave the help around Rs. 300000/-. Remaining amount I brought debts with my well wishers and paid that bill. After getting discharge we went to Vivekananda yoga kendra for strength. Since then we took ayurvedic medicine also along with tablets (3rd tablet to treat the cancer which works partially after chemo) on elders suggestion. But ayurvedic medicine also not worked in that stage.

Finally we went to CMC hospital, Vellore for better treatment in December, 2015. They did all blood tests and told that once again want to give chemo because cancer cells are improved. After that the Bone Marrow Transplant (BMT) will be perform. For chemo therapy (10 lakhs) and BMT(20 lakhs) they told 30 lakhs without complications. If any complication occurs the cost will be increase based on side effects.

Now i have Rs.500000/- only in my hand. I sold out my share in a small school for Rs.500000/-. Doctors told to deposit Rs.400000/- initially. With that they will start chemo. Remaining balance I want to set at the time of treatment. We have a small girl child aged about 16 months, i want to save Bhargavi for that child. Rural Development Update



Agriculture - Youth has to look after: It is an undisputable fact, everyone has to agree in the Country is that Agriculture creating major livelihood in the villages. Village life endowed with natural beauty and imbibed by rich tradition and cultural heritage. Agriculture plays prominent role in the system of village and further festivals are part of our lives. Be it a national celebration or a religious event, an extraordinary enthusiasm can be observed in the entire nation. Agriculture in India has such a relevant and respected status that there are many agrarian festivals as well, ex: Pongal is a harvest festival. The farmer who cultivates land depends in entirety on cattle, rain and the Sun. Once a year, he expresses his gratitude to these natural resources during the harvest festival. This festival will make all of us to go back to our village irrespective of our profession. Such is the connect with our land. Agriculture has significant growth in production and productivity of crops after independence. The rural poverty has also reduced considerably. Despite these achievements, we are still hearing news about suicides, crop failures, un-remunerative prices for crops and poor returns over the cost of cultivation. The major problems that existing now in agriculture industry:

1. Input costs increased drastically.
2. Disparity in getting the seeds, pesticides, subsidy, crop insurance still dominating
3. Labour costs are not in reach for the middle class farmers.
4. Marketing the produce for the benefit of the farmers also playing vital role
5. Farming communities are not able to try modern farming methods.

Solutions to make agriculture profitable: I strongly believe that government alone is not responsible for the current situation in agriculture sector in the Country, but we are equally responsible. While expecting Government take corrective initiative for the prevailing situation, I suggest following points can be taken note by the Govt/ NGOs/ Associations/ individuals who want to support this industry.

1. Need to reduce the input costs is an urgent action point. The Government price regulatory authorities should work in this direction. They should not allow manufacturers to produce 4 rupees medicine for the 1 rupee chick.
2. Mechanization should be increased. Government has to encourage NGOs, SHG and farmer groups to keep agriculture machineries in reach for every village on rental basis thereby address ever growing labour issues.
3. There are few villages/farmers using 80% of the land for regular crops like paddy and wheat and where as 20% of the land and efforts being spent on vegetables farming and cattle management. The 20 % effort can help the family for daily expenditure.

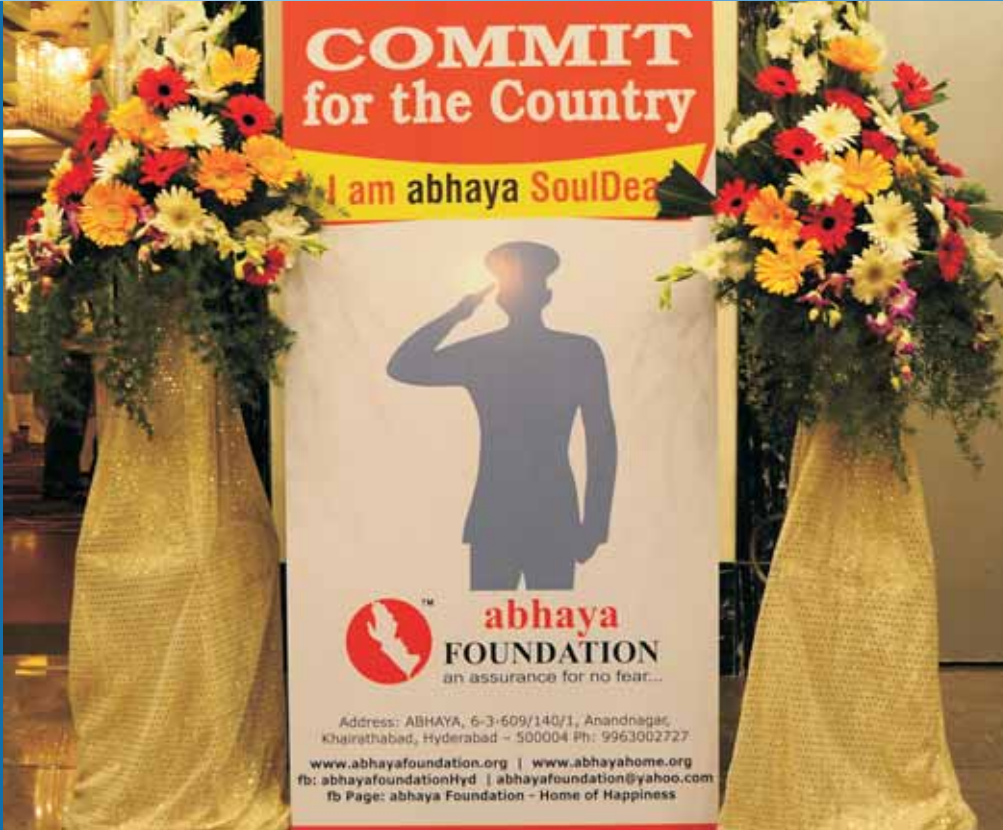
