“HEART” Health Care Update

Sofiya Glory, Bangalore: The Karnataka Govt. NOC, we expect that we may get the permission by this week end. We wish to update the financial status for the surgery.

We have received total Rs. 2,23,500/- (including Abhaya foundations 1.5 lakhs) for the child's medical treatment. The expenses incurred for the child's multiple hospitalisations ,(ONative kidney removal) hemodialysis, medicines and work up for the mother (Kidney Donor) is Rs. 1,32,955/-. As on 28.09.2010, the amount balance in her account is Rs.90,545/-. **We may further need Rs.2,00,000/- in the child's account before the surgery. This has been informed to the child's parents.**

We request you to kindly do the needful in terms of financial support. We are grateful to Abhaya member Mr. Thirupal for giving his time and effort in getting all the necessary certificate to obtain the NOC form Karnataka Govt. Now I am in need and thought it fit to reach out to everybody whom I have come across in my life and whose address I have. I have taken the liberty to write to you on a subject beyond the scope of our relationship. I hope you pardon this intrusion and read further despite your busy schedule.

One of the activities I undertake apart from my consulting profession is rendering service to the needy. I characterize my need to pay back my debt to society through Rotary. I am presently the Chairman of the projects committee in my club "Rotary Bangalore Southwest". Over the years our club has made a name for itself by specializing in community service projects rendering sacor and solace far and wide. 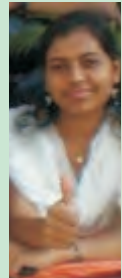

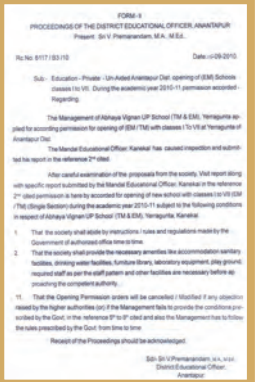

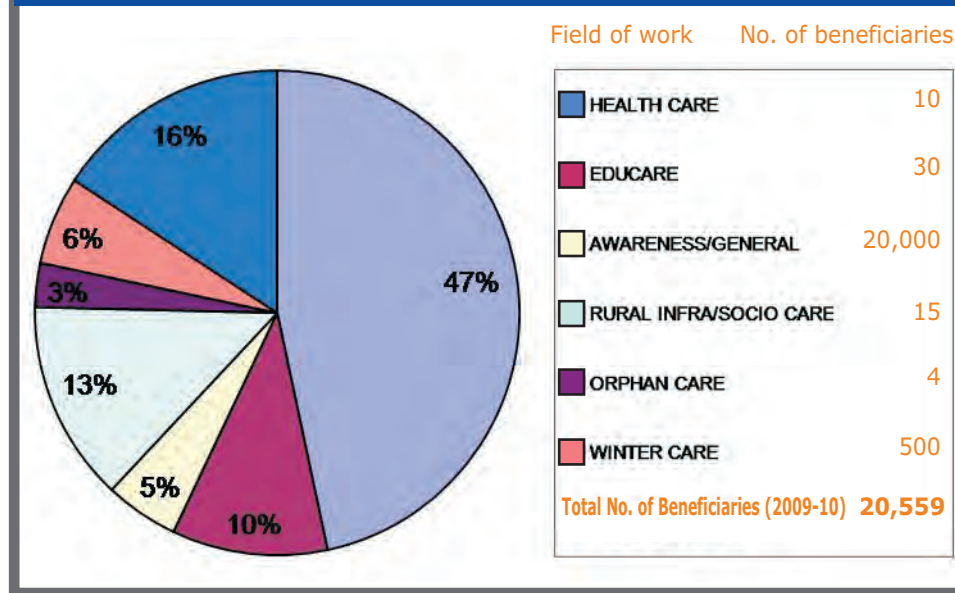
Abhaya Annual Accounts for the year 2009-10 being closed:
