**We will be happy to have your kind feedback for the news update. Further will be grateful if you can share this news letter with your near and dear and seek their support too!!**

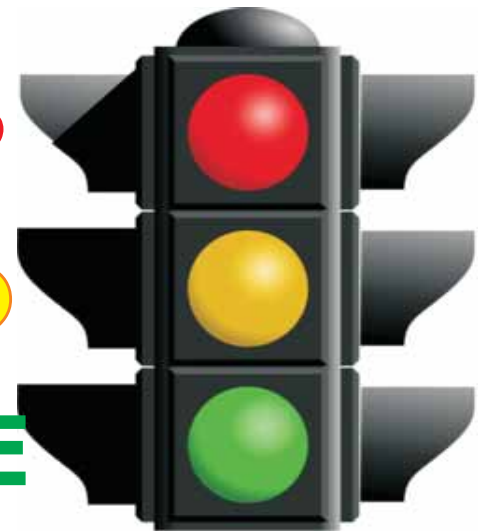

**A. To Whom CSR will applicable ?**

Every company having

- net worth of rupees five hundred crore or more, or
- turnover of rupees one thousand crore or more or
- a net profit of rupees five crore or more during any financial year

**B. What is meaning of any financial year mentioned above?**

General Circular No. 21/2014, dated 18/06/2014

“Any Financial year” referred under sub-section (1) of Section 135 of the Act read with Rule 3 (2) of Companies CSR Rule, 2014 implies any of the three preceding financial years.

As per ICSI FAQ'S

A company which meets the criteria in any of the preceding three financial years (i.e . 2011-12, 12-13, 13-14) but which does not meet the criteria in financial year 2014-15 will need to constitute CSR Committee and comply with provisions of 135 (2) to (5) in the year 2014-2015.

**C. If the company has made profits in the years earlier to 2011-2012, then is there need to comply with the provisions of Section 135?**

if the company has made profits in the years earlier to 2011-2012 but not in The years 2011-12, 2012-13 ot 2013-14 it need not comply with section 135.

**D. For compliance under section135 i.e. Corporate Social Responsibility, from which Financial Year CSR Expenditure & Reporting Begins?**

The constitution of CSR Committee, preparation of CSR Policy, the spending of amount on CSR activities needs to be

during the financial year 2014-15.

**E. If section 135 applicable on any company for f.y. 2014-2015 then what is the time period for investment on CSR activity?**

Companies have to spend the amount on CSR activities as required by section 135 during the F.Y. 2014-15 and Reporting of the same would be in 2015 Board's Report or otherwise state the justification for the same in Board Report.

**F. Whether expenditure by Company for fulfillment of any Act/Statute of Regulations will be count as CSR expenditure?**

No,  
Would not count as CSR expenditure.

**G. In case the company has appointed personnel exclusively for implementing the CSR activities of the company, can the expenditure incurred towards such personnel in terms of staff cost etc. be included in the expenditure earmarked for CSR activities?**

Salary paid by the companies to regular CSR staff as well as to volunteers of the Companies (in proportion to company's time/hours spent specifically on CSR) can be factored into CSR project cost as part of the CSR expenditure.

**H. Whether CSR applicable on private limited company also?**

Yes,  
If private Company fulfil the criteria given under section 135 (1) then CSR will be applicable on that private limited company also.

**I. As per Section Constitution of CSR committee required on Independent Director, whether this condition applicable on Private Company also.**

No.  
In case of Private Limited Company, CSR Committee may consist only two Board of Directors.

**J. Whether CSR expenditure of a company can be claimed as a business expenditure?**

The Finance Act, 2014 provides that any expenditure incurred by an assessee on the activities relating to corporate social responsibility referred to in section 135 of the Companies Act, 2013 shall not be deemed to be an expenditure incurred by the assessee for the purposes of the business or profession. Accordingly, the amount spent by a company towards CSR cannot be claimed as business expenditure.

**K. Whether the average net profit criteria in section 135(5) is Net profit before tax or Net profit after tax?**

**NET PROFIT BEFORE TAX**

The explanation to section 135(5) states that "average net profit" shall be calculated in accordance with section 198 of the Companies Act, 2013. In terms of section 198(5)(a) in making computation of net profits, income-tax and super-tax payable by the company under the Income-tax Act, 1961 shall not be deducted. Therefore, the net profit criterion in section 135(5) is net profit before tax.

**L. Can the CSR expenditure be spent on the activities beyond Schedule VII ?**

MCA vide General Circular No. 21/2014 dated June 18, 2014 has clarified that the statutory provision and provisions of CSR Rules, 2014, is to ensure that while activities undertaken in pursuance of the CSR policy must be relatable to Schedule VII of the Companies Act 2013. However, the entries in the said Schedule VII must be interpreted liberally so as to capture the essence of the subjects enumerated in the said Schedule. The items enlisted in the Schedule VII of the Act, are broad-based and are intended to cover a wide range of activities.

**M. Whether following activities would be qualified CSR Expenditure?**

**N. Merely being a holding or subsidiary company of a company which fulfils the criteria under section 135(1) make the company liable to comply with section 135, unless the company itself fulfils the criteria**

No, It doesn't make the company liable to comply with section 135, unless the company itself fulfils the criteria.

**O. If section 8 company fulfils the criteria of section 135(1) then, whether provisions of CSR are applicable on Section 8 Company?**

There is no specific exemption given to section 8 companies with regard to applicability of section 135, hence section 8 companies are required to follow CSR provisions

**P. Can donation of money to a trust by a company be treated as CSR expenditure of the company?**

The Ministry of Corporate Affairs has vide General Circular No. 21/2014 dated June 18, 2014 has clarified that Contribution to Corpus of a Trust/ Society/ Section 8 companies etc. will qualify as CSR expenditure as long as (a) the Trust/ Society/ Section 8 company etc. is created exclusively for undertaking CSR activities or (b) where the corpus is created exclusively for a purpose directly relatable to a subject covered in Schedule VII of the Act

**Q. In case of companies having multi-locational operations, which local area of operations should the company choose for spending the amount earmarked for CSR operations?**

As per ICSI FAQ no. 44

Proviso to Section 135(5) of the Companies Act 2013 provides that a company shall give preference to the local area and the areas around it where it operates for Spending the amount earmarked for CSR activities. In case of multi-locational operations, the company could exercise discretion in choosing the area for which it wants to give preference.

**R. If a company having turnover of more than Rs. 1000 crores or more has incurred loss in any of the preceding three financial years, then whether such company is required to comply with the provisions of the section 135 of the Companies Act, 2013?**

As per the provisions of section 135 of the Act, one of the three criteria has to be satisfied to attract Section 135. Therefore, if a company satisfies the criterion of turnover, although it does not satisfy the criterion of net profit, it is required to comply with the provisions of Section 135 and the Companies (CSR Policy) Rules, 2014. But, since there are no profits, the company may not spend any amount but explain the reasons for not spending the amount in its Boards Report.

- S. **What is the treatment of expenses incurred beyond that of mandated CSR spend ? (or) There are instances of CSR activities that are in the project mode which require funds beyond that of the mandated 2%. Will such expense, where incurred, be counted in subsequent Financial years as part of CSR expenditure?**

As per ICSI FAQ- 54

In terms of section 135(5), the board of every company, to which section 135 is applicable, shall ensure that the company spends, in every financial year, at least 2% of the average net profits of the company made during the three preceding year.

There is no provision of spreading over the expenditure incurred in a particular year over the next few years. The words used here is at least. Therefore any Expenditure over 2% could be considered as voluntary higher spend. However, in case, a company does not want to spend the 2% in the subsequent year on account of it having spent a higher amount in the previous year, the Board's report may state so.

- T. **Whether it is mandatory to display CSR activity on website?**

The Board of Directors of the company shall, after taking into account the recommendations of CSR Committee, approve the CSR Policy for the company and disclose contents of such policy in its report and the same shall be displayed on the company's website, if any

- U. **Whether reporting of CSR is mandatory in Board report?**

The Board's Report of a company covered under these rules pertaining to a financial year commencing on or after the 1st day of April, 2014 shall include an annual report on CSR containing particulars specified in Annexure.

- V. **There is no need to prepare director report for Foreign company so whether it is mandatory for foreign Company also to give reporting of CSR activity?**

In case of a foreign company, the balance sheet filed under sub-clause (b) of subsection (1) of section 381 shall contain an Annexure regarding report on CSR.

- W. **Whether profit arise from surplus of CSR activity form part of profit of the company**

No,

The surplus arising out of the CSR projects or programs or activities shall not form part of the business profit of a company

- X. **Whether contribution to political party consider as CSR activity?**

NO,

Contribution of any amount directly or indirectly to any political party under section 182 of the Act, shall not be considered as CSR activity.

- Y. **Whether CSR projects or programmes for employee of the Company and their family will form part of CSR activity?**

NO,

The CSR projects or programs or activities that benefit only the employees of the company and their Families shall not be considered as CSR activities in accordance with section 135 of the Act'

- Z. **Whether CSR projects and programme undertake outside India consider as CSR activity?**

NO,

CSR projects and programme undertake in India only consider as CSR activity.

- AA. **Whether company can collaborate with another company for CSR activity and project?**

A company may also collaborate with other companies for undertaking projects or programs or CSR activities in such a manner that the CSR committees of respective companies are in a position to report separately on such projects or programs

- BB. **How to calculate net profit for the purpose of Section 135?**

For the purposes of section 135 "average net profit" shall be calculated in accordance with the provisions of Section 198

**CC. What should be the compliance if company fails to spend such amount on corporate social responsibility?**

if the company fails to spend such amount, the Board shall, in its report made under clause (o) of Sub-Section (3) of Section 134, specify the reasons for not spending the amount

**DD. Is CSR spending required to be done by the Company directly or such amounts can be contributed to charity/ NGO/ section 25 company. Will such contribution qualify as CSR spend?**

Yes. Contribution by the Company to such trusts, NGOs etc also qualify for CSR spend if it meets the track record and other criteria as per Rule 4(2) of Companies (CSR Policy) Rules, 2014.

**EE. Treatment of shortage in CSR spend and disclosure and possibility of carry forward of excess spending of CSR. Is there any need for creation of a provision in the event of a shortage in spending?**

Any shortfall in spending in CSR shall be explained in the financial statements and the Board of Directors shall state the amount unspent and reasons for not spending that amount. Any such shortfall is not required to be provided for in the books of accounts. However, if a company has

already undertaken certain CSR activity for which a contractual liability has been incurred then, a provision for the requisite amount payable to record that liability needs to be recognized as per the applicable Accounting Standards.

Any amount excess spent (i.e., more than 2% as specified in Section 135) cannot be carried forward to the subsequent years. However, the company is entitled to disclose in their Annual Reports of subsequent years any such excess spending of Previous years while giving reasons for not spending in those later years.

**FF. Whether any dividend received from other companies in India will be include in Net Profit?**



Any dividend received from other companies in India, which are covered under and complying with the provisions of section 135 of the Act as well as any dividend received from a company incorporated outside India shall also be excluded from the Net Profit. - **Divesh Goyal, +91-8130757966, Company Secretary, csdiveshgoyal@gmail.com**

## Study Finds Need for Effective CSR Mechanism

A national level exploratory study conducted by the Centre for Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) at the Institute of Public Enterprise (IPE) has stressed the need for an effective mechanism to infuse life into CSR programs.

As corporates today have realized the importance of CSR and are coming up with various initiatives, the IPE conducted the study to understand the scope of CSR as a tool for social inclusiveness. The research was aimed at studying existing CSR practices and also reflect on the role of various stakeholders in its effective implementation. An impact assessment study was also conducted to understand the effectiveness of CSR. The study was conducted in the backward districts of four states, Telangana, Odisha, Rajasthan and Madhya Pradesh, and covered 1846 households.



## New policy allows co's to help irrigation through CSR

NAGPUR: The state government has decided to improve water use efficiency in agriculture sector by asking companies to help through their CSR (corporate social responsibility) initiatives. "The CSR activities offer will include constructing passes for animals on canals going through wildlife sanctuaries," said a senior water resources department (WRD) official.

Challenges in water sector are enormous and it is necessary to maintain the right equilibrium in order to achieve food security, increase living standards, maintain water quality, and to develop and conserve the precious ecosystem, says the new policy announced on April 10.



## The lifetime value of your CSR



For many organisations corporate social responsibility is the new marketing strategy. Here are five reasons how you could benefit from it

For quite some time now, organisations have been haunted by this poser: Will doing good for society pay off? This question has now become even more crucial after recent changes to Section 135 of the Companies Act, which make it almost an obligation for firms to spend 2 per cent of their previous three years' profit after tax (PAT) on corporate social responsibility (CSR), failing which the reasons for not spending have to be explained. The fundamental issue looming up for firms today is, "How will my CSR spend pay off?"

To answer this question, let's look at what some of the market leaders are already doing.

Hindustan Unilever (HUL), for example, through its Shakti project, developed 46,000 Shakti Ammas across 2.5 lakh villages in India, and trained them to be entrepreneurs who made a living by selling HUL products. In return, these women give HUL access to around 1,000 villages that were difficult

markets for HUL to serve.

### **Lesson 1: CSR being used for market development**

Another example is that of Godrej Consumer Products Ltd. GCPL runs a CSR programme called "Good and Green," which encourages beauty training for poor girls in villages.

These girls, from low-income families, are given a kit containing products manufactured by GCPL that can be used by them after training. GCPL is also using the CSR route to increase adoption of its products among first-time consumers at the bottom of the pyramid.

**Lesson 2: CSR can be used to increase product penetration and implement the marketing strategy of "catch them young and catch them first." Remember, there are many first-time customers waiting to be tapped.**

Another successful model comes from Jindal Steel. The company has partnered local communities through self-help groups and NGOs to improve skills and income-generating capabilities of poor families. In one such project, the firm has given loans to poor people to open small dairies, tuition centres, even beauty saloons in villages.

**Lesson 3: Firms can invest CSR funds to develop relationships and partnerships with local communities to enhance social capital at the grassroots.**

Firms such as the RPG group, TCS and Tech Mahindra have sent their employees as volunteers and even adopted schools where these volunteers can, in their spare time and during weekends, teach Maths, Science and English. At such places, even placements are provided. Such 'education to employment'-based CSR initiatives help to connect skills to the market and reduce the skills gap and shortage of such skilled labour.

**Lesson 4: CSR funds can be used to enhance skills and capabilities of your future customers. Making them employable would increase their incomes, which would lead them to become your long-term customers.**

ITC has successfully integrated CSR beneficiaries into its supply chain. The firm's pulpwood plantation has adopted tribal communities and other poor farmers by raising pulpwood plantation. In its agarbatti business, more women are being trained with greater financial support, to enable them to produce agarbatti, thus linking them to their business.

**Lesson 5: CSR projects can be invested to extend the supply chain to bring poor communities into the fold of production, sourcing and so on, thus integrating them into the business.**

Overall, CSR is set to become the new marketing strategy for firms in India today. It can manifest itself as cause-related

marketing, or extended supply chains, or even as product brands that flaunt their socially responsible tag. Today, firms have been forced into thinking beyond their customers and shareholders, and instead focus on developing partnerships with other important stakeholders in the society.

Firms must realise that business is only their economic exchange with society, while CSR is their non-economic exchange, which needs their greater attention today! Unless the balance of economic and non-economic exchanges between business and society is maintained, the business sustainability is threatened. Ultimately, business is a part of society and not vice-versa.

## **Companies cannot carry forward excess funds spent on CSR works: ICAI**

Excess amount spent by corporates on CSR activities in a particular fiscal under the companies law cannot be carried forward to subsequent financial years.

With companies preparing to disclose details about CSR expenses in their annual filings, chartered accountants' apex body ICAI has issued detailed set of Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) for its members with regard to reporting of such expenditure.

"Any amount excess spent (more than two per cent as specified in Section 135) cannot be carried forward to the subsequent years," the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI) has said. It said that any shortfall in spending in CSR should be



explained in the financial statements and the board of directors have to state the amount unspent and reasons for the same.

## **Industrialists should adopt villages under CSR: Maha Minister**

Maharashtra Water Supply Minister Babanrao Lonikar today asked industrialists to adopt villages under Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) programme to help people who are facing dual problem of drought and unseasonal rains.

Lonikar who was addressing reporters here said under the CSR programme industrialists should adopt villages.

Most of the parts of the state are facing drought condition. Also there have been unseasonal rain and hailstorm. It is responsibility of the industrialists to participate in the CSR to succour drought hit and hailstorm hit people, he said.

The minister further said that some industrialists have shown their eagerness to adopt 25 villages in the district here.

According to him, about 500 villages should be adopted under Jalyukta Shivar Abhiyan, the flagship scheme of state government of providing villages with permanent source of water.



## Companies feel CSR cap counterproductive



As companies prepare to file their annual reports and include the last financial year's corporate social responsibility (CSR) expenditure as required by the Companies Act, 2013, more loopholes and grey areas emerge.

Under the CSR rules, companies can spend up to 5% of their total CSR fund in building CSR capacities of their own personnel or those of implementing agencies. But companies feel this allocation is not enough for them to put in place the required infrastructure, which in turn will enable them to meet the 2% target.

### Garbage disposal finds no takers for CSR

Waste management and disposal feature third on the list of the Swachh Bharat Mission's objectives, but for

companies looking to spend their corporate social responsibility (CSR) funds to clean India, interest in this field is low.

"Ever since the prime minister's announcement of achieving Swachh Bharat by 2019, we have received many queries. But all these are focused on cleaning, sweeping, removing litter and not managing or disposing waste in a sustainable manner," says M. Chidambaram, general secretary, Exnora International, a Chennai-based not-for-profit working on environmental issues, with a special focus on waste management.

But the soon-to-be notified Solid Waste Management Rules, 2015, give some hope to Chintan's Chaturvedi. "The provision for creating material recovery facilities, decentralized composting, improving the working conditions of waste pickers with gloves, health checkups, medical claim, bio-methanation, etc., all require capital cost. And this capital cost can easily be provided for through CSR funds. Large or small companies can now tie up with the existing informal sector to help put in place processes for waste management," she says.

Mahindra Finance using CSR money to fund social startups SustainEarth and Sickle Innovations Non-banking financial company Mahindra Finance is funding two social enterprises through its corporate social responsibility fund, after the new Companies Act amendment allowed investments into startups through incubators to fall under the CSR purview.

The company has partnered with social venture fund Villgro to fund SustainEarth, and with the Indian Institute of Management-Ahmedabad's Centre for Innovation Incubation and Entrepreneurship (CIIE) to fund Sickle Innovations.

Mahindra is investing Rs 20 lakh to Rs 23 lakh in these companies. SustainEarth supplies biogas systems and Sickle works on improving conventional farming through innovative appliances.

Mahindra also plans to help these startups find customers and scale up through their network. "Their network and access to rural population will be of immense benefit to us," said Koushik Yanamandram, cofounder of SustainEarth.

## CSR funds could be used to develop assistive technology

A part of the mandatory corporate charity spending could be directed at the cash-starved government programmes that help develop assistive technologies for physically and mentally challenged individuals, said a top official of a government entity that works on such projects.



"From lab to market, a lot of testing and verification need to be done, which requires a substantial amount of money. A lot of effort is needed to sustain these projects," said Prabhat Ranjan, executive director, Technology Information, Forecasting and Assessment Council, which is the technical partner for the portal. The council is an autonomous think-tank under the department of science and technology and works with the social justice ministry.

## How Sachin transformed an Andhra Pradesh village:



PUTTAMRAJU KANDRIGA (AP), MARCH 31: It took all of four months. Puttamraju Kandriga has gone from being a slummy village to a modern miracle after it was adopted by cricketer-turned-MP Sachin Tendulkar. Concrete roads with tiled pavements, an underground sewage network with a treatment plant, storm-water drains, 24-hour water and power supply, a playground, a community hall...this Andhra Pradesh hamlet about 150 km north of Chennai, with infrastructure that many an Indian city may be proud about, is quite unlike any other in the region or probably even the State. Says the Master Blaster: "We plan to do much more."

It was last November that Sachin stepped in to adopt the village under the Sansad Adarsh Gram Yojana, flagged off by Prime Minister Narendra Modi a month earlier. Unlike other similar high-

profile village adoptions where work is yet to begin on the ground, a lot has already been accomplished in this village thanks to quick decisions and constant supervision. Puttamraju Kandriga is a sleepy little village with just 399 people living in 110 houses. Predominantly made up of Backward Class/ST below-poverty-line families, the people make a living from growing red chillies and lime.

"We had no roads, no toilets in our homes nor did we have running water and uninterrupted power supply till Sachin adopted our village. Today, we have all of those along with excellent roads," says Bhaskar Rao, a chilli farmer-resident, with a mix of happiness and pride.

The model village is a joint effort of the local administration and Sachin who has contributed Rs. 2.79 crore from the MP Local Area Development Scheme (MPLADS) funds, while the Government has sanctioned Rs. 3 crore. "I'm proud that we have been able to



provide basic necessities of life such as running water on tap at home and toilets," Sachin told Business Line over phone from Mumbai. Asked why he chose this village and not one in his home State, Sachin replied: "Puttamraju Kandriga is also in India. I've received support from all over India. Wherever I went I was showered with love and affection which means a lot to me." -

A young mountaineer Bharath from Kurnoor will be making an attempt to conquer Mount Everest. He manages to complete the task, Bharath would be the first person to abharat the feat from Andhra Pradesh. Speaking to newsmen in the city, he reveals that the task is not easy.

"I had to go through a lot of problems after the death of my father three years ago. He is the real source of inspiration for me. I had the dream of climbing the Everest since my childhood and I have always been practicing ever since. The real problem was sponsorship for my dream. I train corporates in mountaineering sessions and earn some money but that is not sufficient to fund my travel. I am really thankful to Abhaya Foundation who came forward to help me," says Bharath.

Bharath will be taking up Prime Minister Narendra Modi's call for Swachh Bharat at the Everest.

"I am starting my journey with 150 flags to dedicate the message of Swachh Bharat to all our Indians. I will hand over each flag to each person and I will complete 150 flags. The message which I want to give out is by 2019, India will celebrate the 150th birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi and this is the significance of those 150 flags," he explained.

"Survival would be a difficult task once a person scales above 6,000 meters which is termed as 'Advanced Base Camp'. I will have to survive only on chocolates and dry fruits," Bharath said.

Bharath paid rich tributes to India's top mountaineer Malli Mastan Babu who was recently declared dead while climbing the Agnes Mountain in Argentina. Bharath opined that lack of satellite communication could have cost him his life.

"There will be no communication once a person scales above 6,000 meters and from there on it's only a person's instinct and foresight which can save him," concluded Bharath.

# From the plateau, Bharath looks to go up the mountain

If 26-year-old Bharath Themmineni scales Mount Everest, he will be the first from post-bifurcation Andhra Pradesh to do so

**HYDERABAD:** Prime Minister Narendra Modi's call for 'Swachh Bharat' is set to echo atop the Mount Everest if 26-year-old Bharath Themmineni scales the world's highest peak.

A native of Kurnool, Bharath will leave the city on Monday for Kathmandu, from where his expedition is set to begin with three team members and Sherpas, who will help them climb the peak.

"I have always wanted to conquer the mountain. I be-

gan training 18 months ago under noted mountaineer Shekhar Babu, who will also accompany us till the base camp," he said at an event here on Sunday evening.

## Rs.25 lakh in expenses

Bharath, who teaches rock climbing at an academy in Bhongir, is being sponsored by the Abhaya Foundation and other companies for this trip. He too pitched in with Rs.5 lakh from his pocket.

"The entire expense will cost each person Rs.25 lakh. I am very thankful to my sister Bindu, who stays in Boston,

US, for helping me monetarily," he stated.

Besides taking Swachh Bharat to the Everest, Bharath has more plans atop the peak. But he has chosen to keep them to himself.

"Only after I reach the top will I reveal what I am going to do there as part of the programme," he mentioned. If he completes the task, he will be the first one to do so from Andhra Pradesh after bifurcation of the State.

To prepare for the arduous climb, Bharath trained at the Himalayan Mountaineering Institute between November and December for a month last year, and also scaled mountains in Uttarakhand and northern Sikkim. Abhaya Foundation founder C.S. Balachandra Sunku said it was the first time that it had sponsored an Everest climb.

Nagaraju, aged 19 years, has just got admission in II year B.Tech, IT Branch, in Vasavi Engg. College, Hyderabad. Since he has done Diploma and secured 71% in ECET, he got admission in II year directly. He belongs to BC-D and is a BPL candidate. His father who was selling fruits in his village Kusnoor-Zaheerabad, died in 2003, and he has 2 sisters, elder one got married and the younger one studying 10th class, living with his mother in their village. He lives with his uncle in Addagutta, Hyderabad, who has been providing him food, clothing etc.,

After his father's death, his mother is working as a agriculture laborer and earning around Rs 4000-5000 a month, with which both she and her daughter are maintaining livelihood. They have an acre of land, which is pledged with SBH for her daughter's marriage and it seems the Bank is likely to waive the same in the recent Govt's scheme of waiver to poor people. This needs to be done still.

He also works as a volunteer, as and when conducted, in the Medical Camps conducted by Sri Satya Sai Organisation and assisting the Doctors in such camps. He has passed 'C' certificate exam in NCC. Now the annual fee comes to Rs. 1,18,000/- and Rs. 35,000/- is compensated by the Govt under BPL student category. Balance Rs.83,000/- is needed.

I advised him to contact his village revenue officials with his elders and plead for financial help from the local MLA quota. He can also meet the Principal of Vasavi College with the help of our abhaya student volunteers in that college (if any) for seeking further reduction in fees. I also suggested him to try to earn some amount by doing some part time job.

After talking to him, I feel his case seems to be genuine, referred by a known person like Ramalingeswararao, and we may think of extending financial help, subject to the foundation getting satisfied about his case. – **EJP Prasad, Coordinator, abhaya RPL**

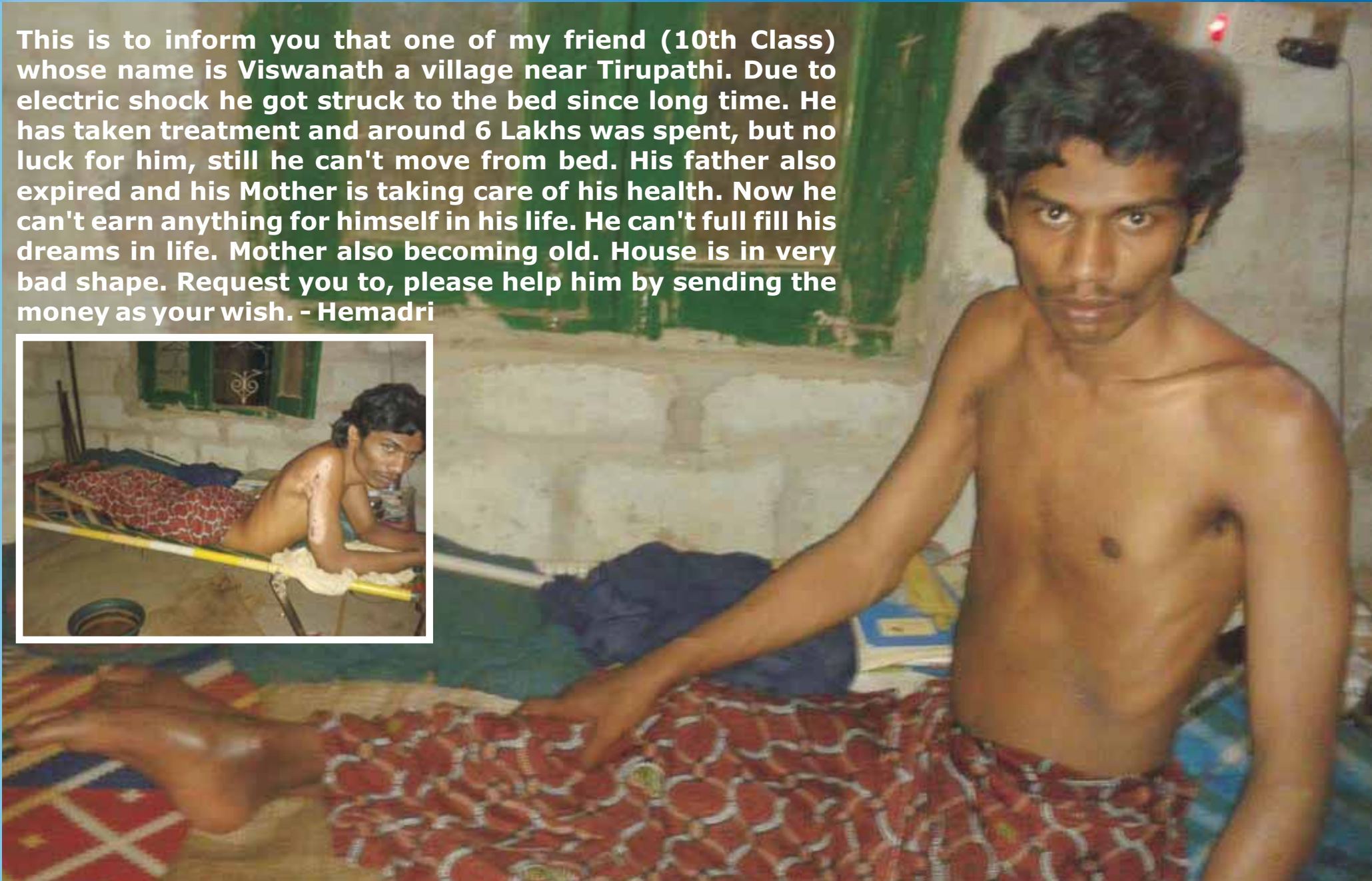
